**SUBJECT: AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE  
COUNTY OF ORANGE AND THE CITY OF VILLA PARK, FISCAL  
YEAR 2002-2003**

### **BACKGROUND**

The County of Orange provides Animal Care Services to the City of Villa Park through the County of Orange Health Care Agency.

Under the Agreement, the County of Orange provides animal care field services including, but not limited to: patrol of assigned areas, impounding of stray dogs or confined stray cats, pickup of wildlife, cruelty investigations, bite investigations, inspection of facilities, responses to service request calls from law enforcement and city officials, and other animal concerns. The County also provides special services to include facility licensing and pet licensing, and vaccination clinics, and shelter services.

The County collects and accounts for all fee revenues under the agreement and reconciles the collections against combined actual costs for service to determine a net cost. The City's combined actual costs are reduced by the amount of license and other fee revenue generated from the City.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The City will make a provisional payment for Fiscal Year 2002/2003 in the amount of \$7,757. The 2002/2003 provisional payment was adjusted due to a Fiscal Year 2000/2001 credit of \$1,644.

The 2002/2003 Operating Budget has a line item of \$14,000 for Animal Care Services.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council approve the Agreement between the City of Villa Park and the County of Orange and authorize the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
