



Villa Park Community Services Foundation Boat Parade Registration Form

You are invited to become a participant in the 14th Annual Great Villa Park Inland Yacht Parade. As a registered participant, not only will you be competing for one of the many awards, your entry will be positioned between the Parade's Official Lead and Endings entries. Completed registration forms must be returned to City Hall prior to 5:00 PM on Friday, December 9. If time permits, last minute registration will be accepted at the start of the parade. Note that entry number tags and parade guidelines will be distributed when you pay at City Hall. The parade will flow through the streets of Villa Park on **Sunday, December 11, 2011**, as part of the "Sailing into Our 50th Year" Celebration! More detailed information is contained in the parade guidelines, and still more may be passed along to boat captains as it becomes available, but the day-of-parade schedule is as follows:

- 3:45 P.M. Parade entries begin to line up northbound in an orderly fashion along Fischen Ranch Road.
- 5:00 P.M. Villa Park Inland Boat parade leaves port for voyage through the streets of V.P.
- 6:30 P.M. Parade entries arrive at Villa Park Towne Centre (Wayne's Liquor); join in the celebration taking place, featuring music, food booths, etc.

For the purposes of the parade, a boat may be defined as "anything that can be towed at a speed of up to five miles an hour." Trees and other obstacles along the dry-land parade route will necessarily limit the height of entries to 15 feet and the width to 10 feet. However, the amount of imagination used in conceiving and subsequently decorating each entry should only be limited by common sense and tastefulness.

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2011 PARADE GUIDELINES

1. NOTE THAT IN ORDER TO RETURN TO THE VILLA PARK TOWNE CENTRE AT A REASONABLE HOUR, THE PARADE STARTS ON TIME.
2. **ALL PARTICIPANTS NEED TO EXERCISE ROADWAY CAUTION AND ACT IN A SAFE MANNER AT ALL TIMES. FOR SAFETY REASONS, PARTICIPANTS MUST RIDE IN A BOAT OR "CRAFT" OF SOME KIND (i.e. NO SKATES OR SKATEBOARDS CAN BE TOWED).**
3. **DO NOT THROW ITEMS FROM YOUR BOAT. THROWING ITEMS FROM YOUR BOAT WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM PARADE.**
4. BE SURE TO PLACE YOUR NUMBER TAGS SO THAT THEY CAN BE SEEN FROM THE FRONT OR FROM BOTH SIDES OF YOUR ENTRY. THE NUMBERS ARE USED TO IDENTIFY YOUR ENTRY FOR THE TELEVISION BROADCAST.
5. THE NUMBER DOES NOT INDICATE THE ORDER IN WHICH YOU WILL LINE UP. AS IN PAST YEARS, LINE UP AS YOU ARRIVE, HEADING EASTBOUND ALONG THE CURB ON TAFT AVENUE. **STOP AS CLOSE TO THE ENTRY AHEAD OF YOU AS SAFELY POSSIBLE.**
6. KEEP UP WITH THE ENTRY AHEAD OF YOU, WHILE MAINTAINING A SAFE SPEED.
7. PAY ATTENTION TO ANY AND ALL DIRECTIONS FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT OR CITY/FOUNDATION STAFF SO AS TO MAINTAIN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT.
8. PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE PARADE STAFF UPON ENTERING THE VP TOWNE CENTRE AT THE END OF THE PARADE, AS THE LAYOUT AND PARKING AREAS MAY BE DIFFERENT THIS YEAR.
9. **ALWAYS PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO CHILDREN NEAR YOUR BOAT WHILE DRIVING ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE.**
