

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-3008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VILLA PARK, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS FOR CITY MEASURES SUBMITTED AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, Sections 9220 and 9285 of the Elections Code of the State of California authorize the City Council, by majority vote, to adopt provisions to provide for the filing of rebuttal arguments for city measures submitted at municipal elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VILLA PARK, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: That pursuant to Sections 9220 and 9285 of the Elections Code of the State of California, when the City Clerk has selected the arguments for and against the measure which shall be printed and distributed to the voters, the City Clerk shall send copies of the argument in favor of the measure to the authors of the argument against, and copies of the argument against to the authors of the argument in favor immediately upon receiving the arguments. The author or the majority of the authors of an argument may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding 250 words or may authorize in writing any other person or persons to prepare, submit or sign the rebuttal argument. The rebuttal arguments shall be filed with the City Clerk, signed with the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the person(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers, not more than ten (10) days after the final date for filing direct arguments. Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the direct arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the direct argument which it seeks to rebut. A rebuttal argument may not be signed by more than five individuals.

SECTION 2: That all previous resolutions providing for the filing of rebuttal arguments for City measures are repealed.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of Section 1 shall apply only to the election to be held on November 4, 2008, and shall then be repealed.

SECTION 4: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
