



Pipeline Safety Meeting

October 24, 4 pm

Villa Park City Hall

Did you know that under Wanda Road is a high pressure petroleum pipeline? Underground pipelines are everywhere. They are the backbone of our nation's energy infrastructure. Because we can't see them, we seldom think about pipelines, their role in our community or their potential hazards.

What is the Wanda Road Pipeline?

This high-pressure petroleum pipeline is operated by Kinder Morgan (KM) and referred to as part of Kinder Morgan's SFPP system.

Where, specifically, is the pipeline located?

Due to security necessities, Kinder Morgan generally refers requests for map information to the National Pipeline Mapping System (NPMS). Generally speaking through, the pipeline cross the 55 freeway running west to east along Arden Villa Dr., then turns south and runs along Wanda Road. The Pipeline is marked at regular intervals by yellow and black signs.

• Know where pipelines are located.

• Always call 811 before you dig.

• Watch, listen and smell for signs of a leak.

What is the pipeline transporting?

This is a multi-products pipeline carrying various grades of gasoline and diesel fuel, as well as both commercial and military turbine fuel.

What happens if there is a pipeline emergency?

Kinder Morgan's Control Center in Orange, CA (ORCC) is manned 24x7 and can be reached by calling either (213) 624-9461 or (213) 624-9462. Public safety officials have additional contact numbers for their use in an emergency.

How does Kinder Morgan maintain the pipeline safety?

Inspections are completed pursuant to the various regulatory requirements, such as internal inspections via smart-tool at intervals not to exceed 5 years, aerial and ground inspections no less than 26 times per year at intervals not to exceed 3 weeks, routine protection inspections, etc. Kinder Morgan policy requires a
