City Manager Sassoon presented a verbal staff report noting a resolution has been drafted encouraging the Orange County Fire Authority to defer any decisions about the future of the Firefighter Reserve Program, and instead explore ways to restructure and strengthen the program.

City Council discussion ensued in favor of the Reserve Firefighter Program.

It was moved by Councilmember Rheins, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Ulmer and carried by the following roll call vote to adopt Resolution No. 2010-3135, in support of the Orange County Reserve Firefighter Program serving Villa Park.
