MUNICIPAL ELECTION MATTERS

1. Consideration of Resolution No. 2010-3144 Reciting the Fact of the Consolidated Municipal Election Held in the City on November 2, 2010, Declaring the Result, and Such Other Matters as Provided by Law

City Clerk Hildenbrand presented the staff report stating California Elections Code Section 10263 states that upon the completion of the canvass of results by the County, prior to the installation of new officers, the City Council shall adopt a resolution reciting the facts of the election and declare elected the persons for whom the highest number of votes were cast for each office.

As indicated in the proposed resolution, the names of the persons elected as Councilmembers for a full term of four years are Robert H. "Bob" Fauteux, Deborah Pauly, and Brad E. Reese. Further, the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council, a statement of the results of the election as follows:

2. Presentation of Appreciation to Outgoing Councilmember Jim Rheins

Council recognized Councilmember Jim Rheins for his dedication and four years of service on the Villa Park City Council and presentations were made by Ed Graham on behalf of Assemblyman Curt Hagman, Louis Bornstein on behalf of Supervisor Bill Campbell, and Lt. Bob Wren on behalf of the Sheriff's Department.

Following the presentations, Councilmember Rheins provided brief remarks then took a seat in the audience.

3. Oaths of Office and Seating of Newly Elected Councilmembers

Mayor MacAloney informed the audience that it was now time for the Councilmembers-elect to be sworn into office and asked the City Clerk to conduct the ceremony.

City Clerk Hildenbrand invited Mr. Bob Fauteux to the center of the room, along with Mr. Mark Wayland, a Trustee for the Orange Unified School District, who administered the Oath of Office for Mr. Fauteux.

Next, City Clerk Hildenbrand invited Councilwoman Deborah Pauly to the center of the room, along with Dr. Stan Van Den Berg, Senior Pastor at Covenant Presbyterian Church of Orange and Villa Park resident, who administered the Oath of Office for Mrs. Pauly.

Finally, City Clerk Hildenbrand invited Lisa and Brad Reese to the center of the room, and Councilmember Reese's wife, Lisa, administered the Oath of Office for Mr. Reese.

After the Oath of Allegiance was administered, each Councilmember-elect gave brief remarks.

4. Election of Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem by the City Council

Following historical procedures, the election for Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem was conducted. City Clerk Hildenbrand declared the offices of Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem vacant, and opened nominations for the office of the Mayor.

Councilmember Reese nominated Councilmember Ulmer for the position of Mayor. Councilmember Fauteux seconded this nomination.

Councilmember Pauly nominated Councilmember MacAloney for Mayor.

City Clerk Hildenbrand asked if there were any further nominations; after no response, he declared nominations closed.

In order of nominations, a voice vote was taken and the City Clerk declared Councilmember Ulmer as Mayor.

Councilmember MacAloney withdrew his nomination.

Mayor Ulmer provided briefs remarks and opened nominations for the office of Mayor Pro Tem.

Mayor Ulmer nominated Councilmember Reese for Mayor Pro Tem. Councilmember Fauteux seconded this nomination.

Councilmember MacAloney nominated Councilmember Pauly for Mayor Pro Tem.

City Clerk Hildenbrand asked if there were any further nominations; after no response, he declared nominations closed.

In order of nominations, a voice vote was taken and the City Clerk declared Councilmember Reese as Mayor Pro Tem.
