

**City of Villa Park
Proclamation of Local Emergency
January 13, 2005**

WHEREAS, Article 2A-1 of the Villa Park Municipal Code of the City of Villa Park empowers the City Manager serving as the Director of Emergency Services for the City of Villa Park to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager/Director of Emergency Services of the City of Villa Park does hereby find; that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the City, caused by the torrential rains and flooding which began on or about January 3, 2005; and that these conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City, and; that the City Council is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED, that a local emergency now exists throughout the City, and;

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law, by ordinances, and by resolutions of the City, and; that this emergency proclamation shall expire in 7 days after issuance unless confirmed and ratified by the governing body of the City of Villa Park.
