DISCUSSION AGENDA

1. Review of Featherhill Drive Traffic Calming Request
Residents of Featherhill Drive have requested that the City implement some form of traffic calming measure on their street due to excess speed from drivers.

Recommendation: That the Community Development Committee review potential traffic calming measures, receive public input, and provide direction for staff.

2. Review of Prado Woods Drive Parking
Residents of Prado Woods Drive have requested that the City review the parking impacts from Villa Park High School students. Similar review in the past led to the consideration of a two-hour parking limitation on Prado Woods Drive and Huntington Circle, however, that item was denied by Council in September, 2005.
