Read the following, initial, sign and date:

___ Agreement: that any City personnel or equipment used in connection with the activity will be paid for by permittee and that the City shall be compensated for any loss or damage to City property; and agreement to clean and restore the property to its condition prior to its use as a location site.

___ Indemnification: The permittee guarantees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, and employees, and each of them against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, liabilities and judgments of every kind and nature, regardless of the merit of the same, arising out of or related to the exercise of any permit granted pursuant to the provisions of this policy, including costs for investigations, attorney's fees and court costs in the defense of any actions, to the extent that such claims or demands are alleged to be the result of an error, omission, international act or negligent act or any persons employed by permittee.

___ Enforcement Actions: The city reserves the right to discontinue a pool discharge permit at any time that it is determined the discharger is not in compliance with the terms of the permit. The occurrence of an illegal discharge of pool water may be considered grounds for future denial of a discharge permit request. Also, if at any time the City is required to respond to an illegal discharge of pool water, fines may be assessed to the property owner to recover costs including, but not limited to, administrative costs, clean-up response costs and all other costs determined necessary to mitigate any negative impacts resulting from the event.

___ Discharging Guidelines: All information required in obtaining compliance to discharge of pool water into the public right-of-way can be found in the "Tips for Pool Maintenance" brochure at the front counter of the City or the Orange County Stormwater Program website www.ocwatersheds.com.
